Q63: Leader: Which is the fifth commandment?

All: The fifth commandment is, Honor thy father and thy mother: that thy days may be long upon the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee.

Q64: Leader: What is required in the fifth commandment?

All: The fifth commandment requireth the preserving the honor, and performing the duties, belonging to everyone in their several places and relations, as superiors, inferiors, or equals.

Q65: Leader: What is forbidden in the fifth commandment?

All: The fifth commandment forbiddeth the neglecting of, or doing anything against, the honor and duty which belongeth to everyone in their several places and relations.

Sunday: Prayer Theme—**Cleansing and Forgiveness** - *For who is a God like you, pardoning iniquity and passing over transgression for the remnant of your inheritance? You do not retain your anger forever, because you delight in steadfast love. O that you would have compassion upon us and tread our iniquities underfoot and cast all our sins into the depths of the sea. Micah 7:18-19*

Monday: Prayer Needs – **Matlack/MTW Prayer Ministry:** *We have reason to love you, O LORD, because you have heard the voice of our pleas for mercy, Psalm 130:2 and because you have inclined your ear to us; we will therefore call upon you as long as we live. Psalm 116:1-2*

Tuesday: *We thank you that having bore the sin of many, Christ makes intercession for transgressors, Isaiah 53:12 and prays, not only for those who were given to him when he was on earth, but also for all those who will believe in him through their word; that they may all be one. John 17:20-21*
