Sunday: Prayer Theme—**Grace Abounding** – Now the law came in to increase the trespass, but where sin increased, grace abounded all the more, so that, as sin reigned in death, grace also might reign through righteousness leading to eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord. **Romans 5:20-21** For the law was given through Moses; grace and truth came through Jesus Christ. **John 1:17**

Monday: Prayer Needs – **Etienne/Haiti** - God is able to make all grace abound to you, so that having all sufficiency in all things at all times, you may abound in every good work. **2 Corinthians 9:8** So, let us then with confidence draw near to the throne of grace, that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of need. **Hebrews 4:16**

Tuesday: But the free gift is not like the trespass. For if many died through one man's trespass, much more have the grace of God and the free gift by the grace of that one Man Jesus Christ abounded for many. **Romans 5:15**

Wednesday: What shall we say then? Are we to continue in sin that grace may abound? By no means! How can we who died to sin still live in it? Do you not know that all of us who have been baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into His death? We were buried therefore with Him by baptism into death, in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, we too might walk in newness of life. **Romans 6:1-4**

Thursday: "My grace is sufficient for you, for My power is made perfect in weakness." Therefore I will boast all the more gladly of my weaknesses, so that the power of Christ may rest upon me. **2 Corinthians 12:9**

Friday: Give thanks for our church body and pray for our sanctification, the Pastors, the Elders and Deacons, and **Jai and Esther Mahtani.** For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God, not a result of works, so that no one may boast. **Ephesians 2:8-9**

Saturday: *In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of our trespasses, according to the riches of His grace.* **Ephesians 1:7**
