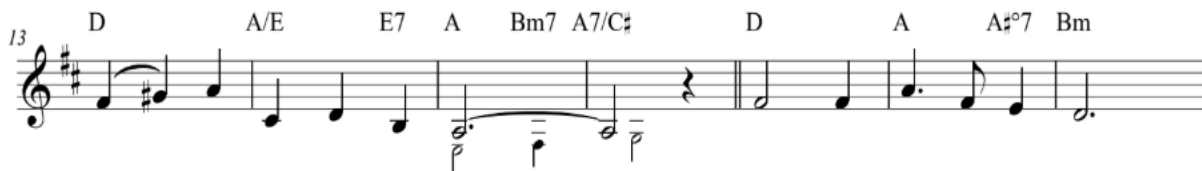

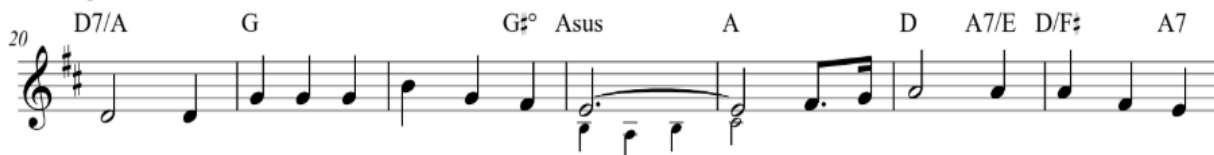

Sunday: Prayer Theme—**Substitutionary Atonement** – *Then Jesus, knowing all that would happen to Him, ...said to them, "Whom do you seek?" They answered Him, "Jesus of Nazareth." Jesus said to them, "I am He...let these men go." ...So the band of soldiers and their captain and the officers of the Jews arrested Jesus and bound Him. ...It was Caiaphas who had advised the Jews that it would be expedient that one man should die for the people. **John 18:4-5, 8, 14***

Monday: Prayer Needs – **Aldo Mondin/RUF@USF** – *We know that as You are gracious and merciful, so You are the righteous God who loves righteous deeds, **Psalm 11:7** and will by no means clear the guilty. **Exodus 34:7** But Jesus Christ has become to us righteousness from God; **1 Corinthians 1:30** being made to be sin, though He knew no sin, so that in Him we might become the righteousness of God. **2 Corinthians 5:21***

Tuesday: *(For the full satisfaction which Christ made to the justice of God for the sin of man by the blood of His cross, for the purchases, victories, and triumphs of the cross, and for all the precious benefits which flow to [us] from the dying of the Lord Jesus.) That He has redeemed us from the curse of the law by becoming a curse for us. **Galatians 3:13***

Wednesday: *Have You not Yourself put forward Your Son, Christ Jesus, as a propitiation for sin by His blood, to be received by faith; to show God's righteousness for the remission of sins, to show Your righteousness at the present time, so that You might be just and the Justifier of the one who has faith in Jesus? **Romans 3:25-26** And so, we now receive reconciliation. **Romans 5:11***

Thursday: *That He was wounded for our transgressions and crushed for our iniquities; that upon Him was the chastisement of our peace, and with His stripes we are healed; and that the LORD having laid upon Him the iniquity of us all, **Isaiah 53:5-6** We thank You that having bore the sin of many, Christ makes intercession for transgressors, **Isaiah 53:12***

Friday: Give thanks for our church body and pray for our sanctification, the Pastors, the Elders and Deacons, and **Eva Rivera**. *That God has done what the law, weakened by the flesh, could not do, by sending His own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh, who by a sacrifice for sin, condemned sin in the flesh. **Romans 8:3***

Saturday: *Herein indeed God shows His love to us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us, **Romans 5:8** that we might be reconciled to Him by the death of His Son. **Romans 5:10** In this is love, not that we have loved God, but that He loved us and sent His Son to be the propitiation for our sins, **1 John 4:10***
