Let us hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering, for He who promised is faithful. 1.6: The whole counsel of God concerning all things necessary for His own glory, man's salvation, faith and life, is either expressly set down in Scripture, or by good and necessary consequence may be deduced from Scripture: unto which nothing at any time is to be added, whether by new revelations of the Spirit, or traditions of men. Nevertheless, we acknowledge the inward illumination of the Spirit of God to be necessary for the saving understanding of such things as are revealed in the Word: and that there are some circumstances concerning the worship of God, and government of the church, common to human actions and societies, which are to be ordered by the light of nature, and Christian prudence, according to the general rules of the Word, which are always to be observed.

WSC Q. 2: What rule has God given to direct us how we may glorify and enjoy Him?

ALL: The Word of God, which is contained in the Scriptures of the Old and New Testaments, is the only rule to direct us how we may glorify and enjoy Him.

WSC Q. 3: What do the Scriptures principally teach?



**Sunday:** Prayer Theme—**Through Their Word** – We thank You that having bore the sin of many, Christ makes intercession for transgressors, **Isaiah 53:12** and prays, not only for those who were given to Him when He was on earth, but also for all those who will believe in Him through their word; that they may all be one. **John 17:20-21** 

**Monday:** Prayer Needs – **Etienne/Haiti** – 0 let Your name be great among the nations, **Malachi 1:11** and let all the ends of the earth remember and turn to the LORD, and all the families of the nations worship before You; **Psalm 22:27** and let them proclaim Your righteousness to a people yet unborn. **Psalm 22:31**

Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age." **Matthew 28:18-20**
