
# **Prayer of Adoration and Invocation**

This prayer exalts the Name of the Lord and invokes His presence and Communion as we come to worship Him.





# **Confession of Faith Heidelberg Catechism**

Q. 29: Why is the Son of God called "Jesus," meaning "savior"?

**ALL:** Because He saves us from our sins; and because salvation is not to be sought or found in anyone else.

Q. 30: Do those who look for their salvation and security in saints, in themselves, or elsewhere really believe in the only savior, Jesus?

**ALL:** No. Although they boast of being His, by their actions they deny the only savior, Jesus. Either Jesus in not a perfect savior, or those who in true faith accept this savior have in Him all they need for their salvation.



**Sunday:** Prayer Theme—**Peace** – The Lord of peace Himself give us peace, all peace, at all times in every way, 2 Thessalonians 3:16 That peace which Jesus Christ has left with us, which He gives to us; such a peace as the world can neither give nor take away; such a peace as that our hearts may not be troubled or afraid. John 14:27

**Monday:** Prayer Needs – **Christ the King Chapel** – *Lord, do not lay any stumbling block before* us, so that we should stumble and perish, Jeremiah 6:21 but give us that great peace which they have who love Your law, for nothing can make them stumble. Psalm 119:165

Tuesday: In Christ Jesus let us, who once were far off, be brought near by the blood of Christ; for He Himself is our peace, who has broken down the dividing wall of hostility between us, that He might reconcile us to God through His cross, thereby killing the hostility, and so making peace. Through Him, therefore, let us, who have made ourselves strangers and aliens, become fellow citizens with the saints and members of the household of God. **Ephesians 2:13-19** 

**Wednesday:** Let the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, guard our hearts and our minds in Christ Jesus; **Philippians 4:7** and let that peace rule in our hearts, to which we have been called. Colossians 3:15

Thursday: Being justified by faith, let us have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ, and through Him let us have access into that grace in which believers stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God. Romans 5:1-2 O let us therefore agree with You and be at peace, that thereby good may come to us. Job 22:21

**Friday:** Give thanks for our church body and pray for our sanctification, the Pastors, the Elders and Deacons, and Lucas Sluder. May the God of hope fill us with all joy and peace in believing, so that by the power of the Holy Spirit we may abound in hope. Romans 15:13

**Saturday:** We bless You for the redemption we have through Christ's blood, the forgiveness of our trespasses, according to the riches of Your grace, which You have lavished upon us. Ephesians 1:7-8 You keep him in perfect peace whose mind is stayed on You, because he trusts in You. Isaiah 26:3
