Confession of Faith Westminster Shorter Catechism

Q. 53: Which is the third commandment?

ALL: The third commandment is, *Thou shalt not take the Name of the LORD thy God in vain: for the LORD will not hold him guiltless that takes His Name in vain.*

Q. 54: What is required in the third commandment?

ALL: The third commandment requires the holy and reverent use of God's names, titles, attributes, ordinances, Word, and works.

Q. 55: What is forbidden in the third commandment?

ALL: The third commandment forbids all profaning or abusing of anything whereby God makes Himself known.

Q. 56. What are the reasons annexed to the third commandment?

ALL: The reason annexed to the third commandment is, that however the breakers of this commandment may escape punishment from men, yet the Lord our God will not suffer them to escape His righteous judgment.

Sunday: Prayer Theme— **Salvation** – *The saying is trustworthy and deserving of full acceptance, that Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners, of whom I am the foremost. But I received mercy for this reason, that in me, as the foremost, Jesus Christ might display His perfect patience as an example to those who were to believe in Him for eternal life.* **1 Timothy 1:15-16**

Monday: Prayer Needs – **Gospel Reformation Network (GRN)** – *I pray, as I am taught, for all people, believing that this is good and pleasing in the sight of God my Savior, who desires all people to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth and of Jesus Christ,* **1 Timothy 2:3-4** *who gave Himself as a ransom for all.* **1 Timothy 2:6** *O let Your salvation and Your righteousness be revealed in the sight of the nations, and let all the ends of the earth see the salvation of God.* **Psalm 98:2-3**

Tuesday: *O how wonderfully did the goodness and loving kindness of God our Savior appear! He saved us, not because of works done by us in righteousness, but according to His own mercy:* **Titus 3:4-5** *We had destroyed ourselves, but in You, and You only, was our help.* **Hosea 13:9**

Wednesday: *For those among us who are cast down with burdens and cares, renew a right spirit within them, cast them not away from Thy presence, and take not Thy Holy Spirit from them, but restore unto them the joy of Thy salvation and uphold them with Thy free Spirit,* **Psalm 51:10-12(KJV)** *that their tongues may sing aloud of thy righteousness* **Psalm 51:14(KJV)** *and show forth Thy salvation.* **Psalm 71:15(KJV)**

Thursday: *Deliver us from every evil thing, we pray, that we may do no wrong:* **2 Corinthians 13:7** *save us from our sins; Matthew 1:21 especially the sin which clings so closely.* **Hebrews 12:1** *Conceal pride from us; Job 33:17 put false ways far from us:* **Psalm 119:29** *incline our hearts to Your testimonies, and not to selfish gain;* **Psalm 119:36** *and keep us from speaking rashly with our lips:* **Psalm 106:33** *But especially keep back Your servants from presumptuous sins; let them not have dominion over us!* **Psalm 19:13**

Friday: Give thanks for our church body and pray for our sanctification, the Pastors, the Elders and Deacons, and **Bill Willever** – *Preserve us, we beg You, that no evil thing may be allowed to befall us;* **Psalm 91:10** *and keep us from evil, that it may not hurt us.* **Psalm 121:7** *You who have delivered, please deliver; and, we hope and pray, that You will deliver us again* **2 Corinthians 1:10**

Saturday: *Father in heaven, supply our wants, pardon our sins, and preserve us from evil, for Yours is the Kingdom, the power, and the glory, and you are Lord of all, who bestow Your riches on all who call on You.* **Romans 10:12** *None can forgive sins but You alone;* **Mark 2:7** *let Your power be great in pardoning our sins:* **Numbers 14:17** *And since it is the glory of God to pardon sin,* **Proverbs 25:2** *and to help the helpless, help us, O God of our salvation, for the glory of Your Name; deliver us, and atone for our sins, for Your Name's sake!* **Psalm 79:9**
