Sunday: Prayer Theme – “**A Ransom for Many**” – *For even the Son of Man came not to be served but to serve, and to give His life as a ransom for many.* **Mark 10:45**

Monday: Prayer Needs –**Etienne/Haiti** – *We know that as You are gracious and merciful, so You are the righteous God who loves righteous deeds, Psalm 11:7 and will by no means clear the guilty. Exodus 34:7 But Jesus Christ has become to us righteousness from God; 1 Corinthians 1:30 being made to be sin, though He knew no sin, so that in Him we might become the righteousness of God. 2 Corinthians 5:21*

Tuesday: *We thank You that having bore the sins of many, Christ makes intercession for transgressors, Isaiah 53:12 and prays, not only for those who were given to Him when He was on earth, but also for all those who will believe in Him through His Word; that they may all be one. John 17:20-21*

Wednesday: *You were ransomed from the futile ways inherited from your forefathers, not with perishable things such as silver or gold, but with the precious blood of Christ, like that of a lamb without blemish or spot. 1 Peter 1:18-19*

Thursday: *Herein indeed God shows His love to us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us, Romans 5:8 that we might be reconciled to Him by the death of His Son. Romans 5:10 In this is love, not that we have loved God, but that He loved us and sent His Son to be the propitiation for our sins, 1 John 4:10*

Friday: Give thanks for our church body and pray for our sanctification, the Pastors, the Elders and Deacons, and **Jimmy and Pam Norman** – *That we have an Advocate with the Father, even Jesus Christ the righteous, 1 John 2:1 who is therefore able to save to the uttermost all those who draw near to God as a Father, through Him as a Mediator, since He always lives to make intercession for His people. Hebrews 7:25*

Saturday: *The Son of Man came not to be served but to serve, and to give His life as a ransom for many. Matthew 20:28*
